What is P.A.T.T.?

P.A.T.T. is an acronym that stands for Passing Along the Torch. Currently the focus is on ministering to women, but the thrust does include an umbrella for working with men and children; the family. God gave the inspiration for this ministry to O'Violet J. Oree in 2009 and the first P.A.T.T. Conference was held in March 2010 in Savannah, Georgia. Since then two other conferences were held in Savannah, Georgia, one in Charlotte, N.C., twice in Charleston, S.C., and twice in Beaufort, SC. This is our ninth year and we are in Alpharetta, Ga.

PATT is based on experiences and circumstances that many women have been privy too that can be shared with women who are either facing new challenges in their lives or women who have yet to understand and deal with the struggles of issues that are common to many women in one form or another. So if we have conversations with each other and educate each other we actualize the reality of passing along the torch. PATT is basically a platform for women who need an outlet to share the ministry God has given them. So during this annual conference different women with different types of ministries get that opportunity to facilitate a workshop or speak and present in one form or another. A gathering of women and this year a gathering of teen girls get to hear presenters share many aspects of life that we may encounter. Each story is unique to those that experience it, but the wisdom learned helps all of us know that we can make it no matter how chaotic, balanced, or unbalanced things may be in our lives.

Our PATT Conference is usually in March of each year. We have hosted a Mothers & Daughters brunch and plan to do many more. It is also in our plans to have a Princess Tea, an event to minister to girls five to eighteen. In 2019 our conference will include teenage boys and men. Pretty soon the whole family can be involved. Presenter's Biography

Co-Pastor O'Violet J. Oree



O'Violet J. Oree grew up in Dale, SC. In 1973 she started college life at Baptist College at Charleston, SC. In April 1974, during her first year she received personal salvation. While yet a college student, she met her husband through a friend at the College of Charleston. They met in a revival where she and a lot of other college girls were lifting up the name of Jesus. They were married in August of 1976 and have five wonderful children, who are living prosperous lives of their own.

After receiving a Bachelors of Science Degree at Baptist College at Charleston, now Southern University, she obtained a Master Degree in the Art of Teaching from the College of Charleston. For many years O'Violet has worn many hats and continues being trained in ministry and early child care. In 2009 she and her husband received their Honorary Doctoral Degrees from Grace Hill Bible College. Shortly afterward her husband initiated the start of Grace Hill Bible College at the Adams Run Civic Center and in North Charleston, where she continues to teach now into her ninth year with the bible college.

It was in 2009 that the PATT organization became an inspiration. The first conference was held in 2010 called P.A.T.T., (Passing Along the Torch). For the past eight years she has headed a three days/two night's women's conference in Savannah, Georgia, Charlotte, N.C., Charleston, SC and Beaufort, SC, where many women came together attending workshops on women's issues, while taking a moment to rejuvenate themselves.

It was in June 2011, after 21 years of teaching, she let the job go as the Lord instructed. After a brief six months, O'Violet spent several years directing her own childcare business in North Charleston and Adams Run Children Academy in Adams Run, SC. She closed her personal childcare center in 2016, but still helps in Adams Run. For 29 years O'Violet assisted her husband in pastoring House of God, Miracle Temple, but for the past five years she has been co-pastor while he has been back and forth on mission in Miami, Florida. She no longer has to punch the clock, but as the Lord told her, she works from home. Working from home involves the church, Adams Run Civic Center, PATT, personal property, her desires, and family. To her, the future looks promising.

Evangelist Deborah Dawson



Evangelist Deborah Dawson is poetically known as *Deb De' Poet*. She is a native of South Carolina: born in Columbia and raised in Charleston, South Carolina. As an artist she writes, produces, and directs stage plays and dramatic skits. Deborah takes the art of the spoken word to another level by putting poetry in motion. Poetry in Motion is the name of her playwright group and her God given concept to produce dramatic skits where the poems are acted out simultaneously as the poem is recited. This is the *say* and *see* of poetry. She says it...you see it. Deborah has also had the opportunity to perform in various plays in the low country. She has performed during the Moja Arts Festival, Charleston Black Expo, and Spoleto. An open door was given Deborah, to produce her own show, *The Poet's Place*, on the CTN network. Pamela Waters




